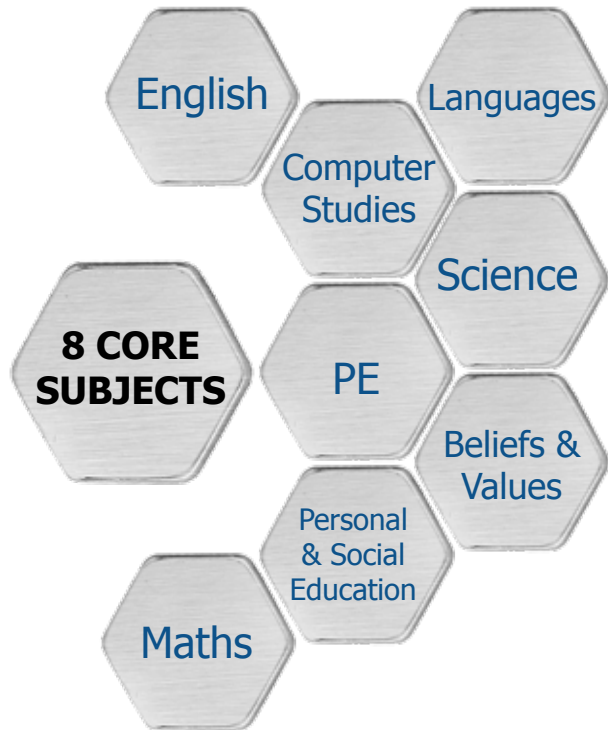

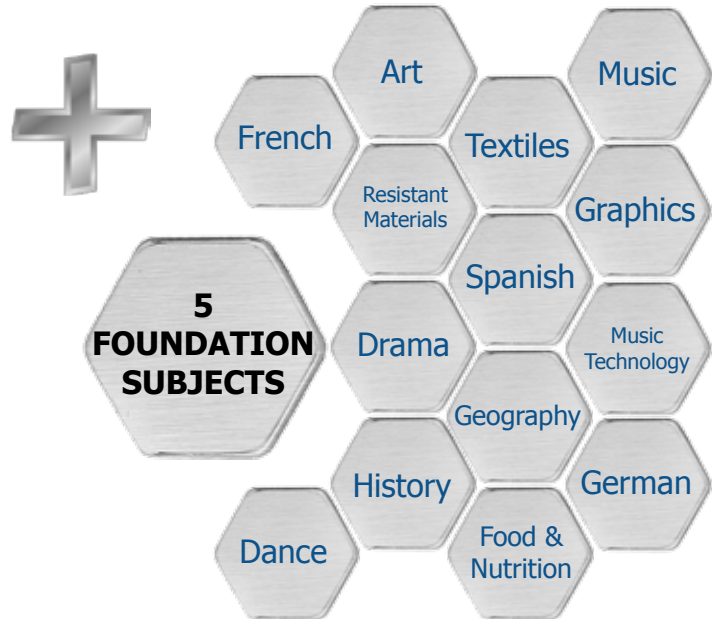
Our 5 Year Learning Journey: Year 7



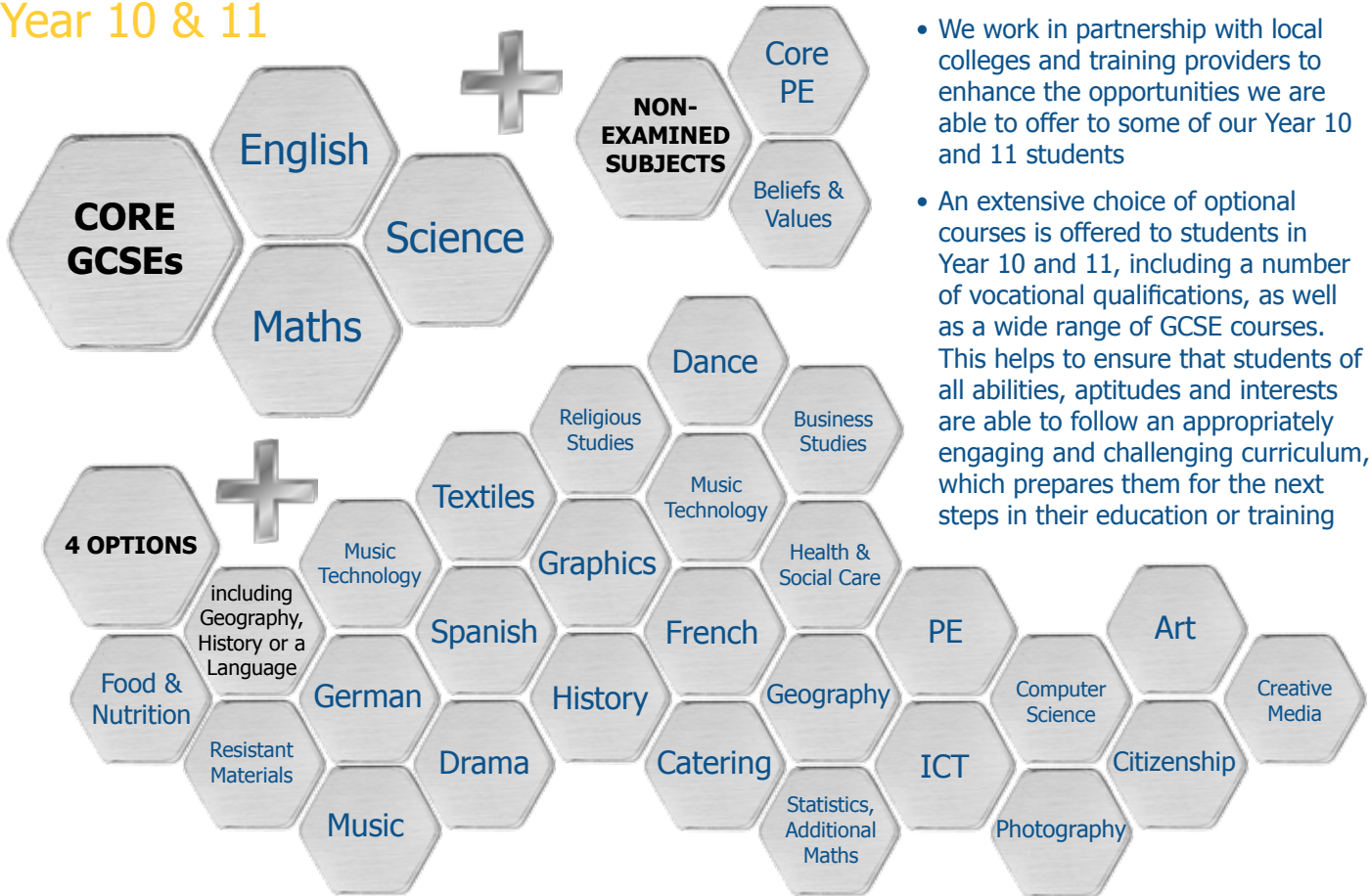
- A broad and balanced curriculum, including technology subjects and creative and performing arts subjects, as well as all of the English Baccalaureate subjects

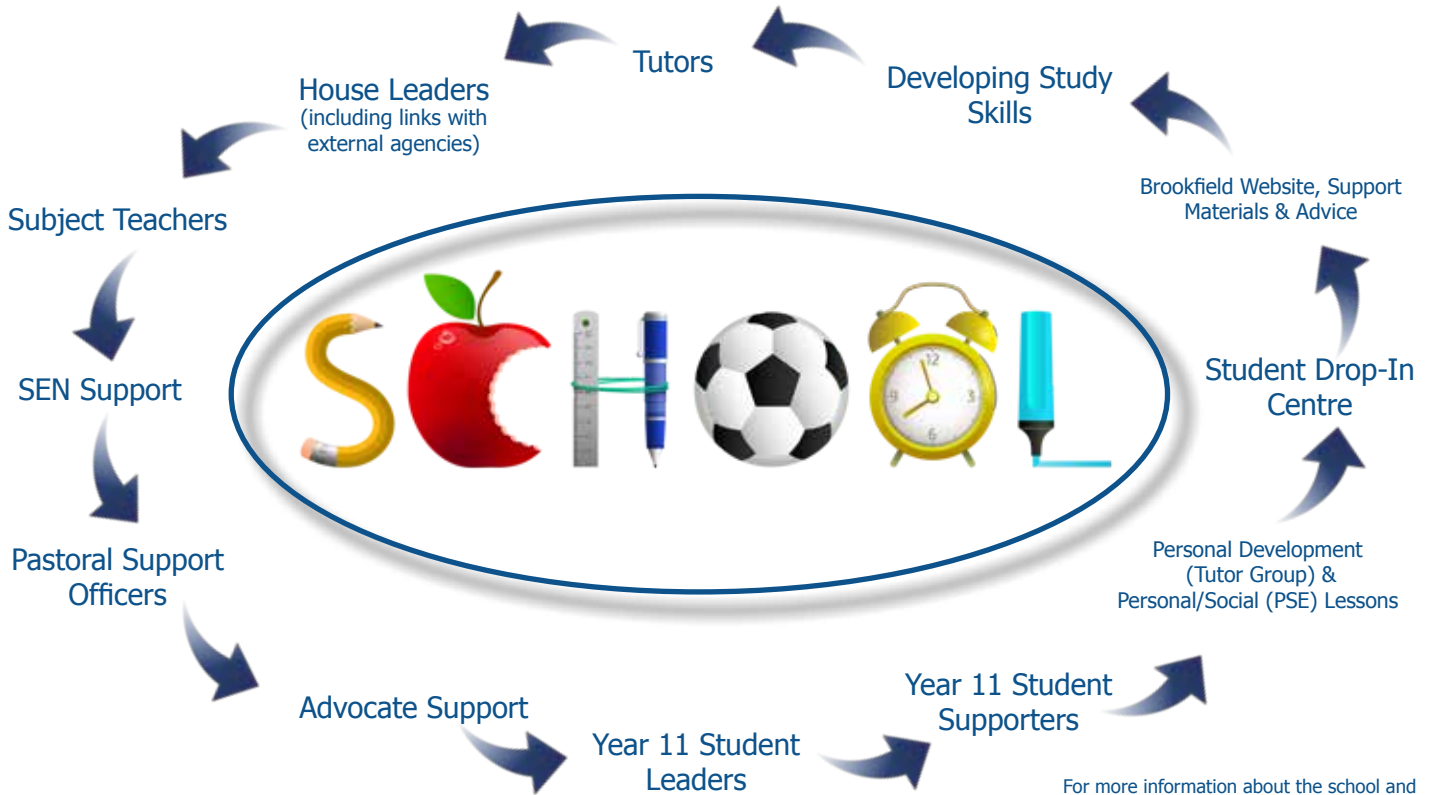
